School Resource Officer (SRO) - 4-Hour Shift
Job Description**

Position Overview

The School Resource Officer (SRO) is responsible for providing safety and security for students, staff, and school property during a 4-hour shift. The SRO will work closely with school administrators, local law enforcement, and school staff to ensure a safe and secure learning environment. This role is focused on addressing immediate security concerns, building relationships with students, and contributing to a positive school climate.

Key Responsibilities

- Provide law enforcement support during school hours, ensuring the safety of students, staff, and visitors.
 - Monitor school grounds, including entrances, hallways, and parking areas, to maintain a visible presence.
 - Respond to emergencies, incidents, and disturbances on school property.
 - Work collaboratively with school administrators and staff to develop and maintain effective school safety protocols.
 - Serve as a mentor for students, offering guidance on safety, conflict resolution, and law-related topics.
 - Investigate and report criminal activity, disturbances, and safety concerns.
 - Assist in the development of safety plans and conduct drills, as necessary.
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Qualifications

- Certification as a law enforcement officer in the state of Ohio.
- Strong communication skills and the ability to interact positively with students, staff, and the community.

- Ability to remain calm under pressure and respond to emergencies in a timely and professional manner.
 - Experience in law enforcement, preferably in a school or community setting.
 - Knowledge of school safety laws, policies, and procedures.
