School Resource Officer (SRO) - 8-Hour Shift  
Job Description**

### **Position Overview**

The School Resource Officer (SRO) is responsible for providing comprehensive safety and security services to students, staff, and school property during an 8-hour shift. The SRO will collaborate with school administrators, staff, and local law enforcement to foster a secure learning environment. This role includes proactive safety measures, emergency response, and student mentoring.

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### **Key Responsibilities**

- Ensure the safety and security of students, staff, and school property throughout the school day.
  - Provide a visible law enforcement presence on school grounds, including monitoring entrances, hallways, and parking areas.
  - Respond promptly to emergencies, disturbances, and criminal activity on school property.
  - Collaborate with school staff and administrators to enhance safety protocols and handle specific safety concerns.
  - Serve as a resource for students, offering guidance on safety issues, conflict resolution, and law-related matters.
  - Investigate criminal activity, report incidents, and provide follow-up as necessary.
  - Assist with the development and execution of school safety plans and emergency drills.
  - Participate in student and staff education programs related to safety, substance abuse prevention, and law enforcement topics.

- Certification as a law enforcement officer in the state of Ohio.
- Strong communication and interpersonal skills.
