### **POSITION SUMMARY:**

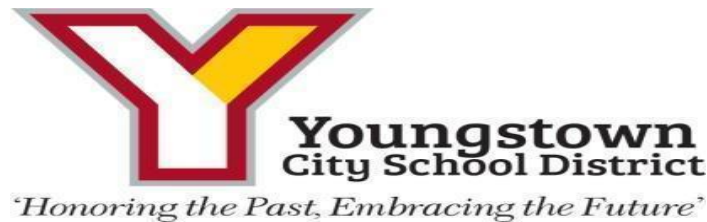
