POSITION SUMMARY:

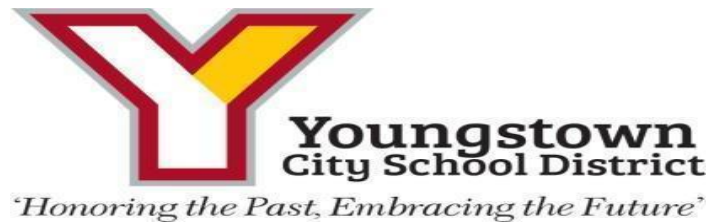
